

## Hotwheels—Upper orbit stuck ball fix

### Purpose:

Reduce/eliminate stuck balls caused by slow rolling balls sitting between post rubber and metal rail at the right top entry to the pop bumper array.

### Procedure:

1. Remove the plastic to the right of the pop bumper array top entry.
2. Grip your needle nose pliers at the end of the top metal rail so that it's holding the entire depth of the rail, without touching the playfield surface.
3. Bend the metal rail so it touches the rubber on the post below.
4. Review your work—With the playfield down, place a ball at the end of rail and rubber. It should take very little to no effort for the ball to move from this position.
5. Put back the plastic and you're done!

### Tools required:

- 11/32" nut driver
- Needle Nose Pliers
