Ghostbusters Flasher #129

Symptoms:

- Upon game power-up the display reads the following messages:
- "Updating Node Board Runtime"
- "Update Failed Please Power Cycle Game"
- Random coils on playfield energize on their own

Problem:

The +5 volt source supplying the "Left Scoop" Flasher #129 intermittently shorts to the metal ball guide rail located underneath it.

Solution:

Insulate the "Left Scoop" Flasher PCB with a non-conductive strip.

Tools Required:


- Phillips Screwdriver
- 1/4" Nut Driver
- 5/16" Nut Driver


Remove the hardware listed securing Plastic #05

- 3 Phillipshead Screws
- 2 5/16" Nuts
- 1 1/4" Hex Spacer



Flip Plastic #05 over in order to inspect the LED flasher PCB. The LED flasher PCB should have a non-conductive Mylar strip or fiche paper protecting the backside of the board.
